Local newspapers: anti-German feelings running high with rumours of German atrocities which came to a head with the sinking of the Lusitania with mainly civilian casualties. This led to riots in East London with attacks and looting of German and Austrian shops. Riots took place over several days/weeks including Tuesday 11 May and Wednesday 12 May 1915.

East London Advertiser - Saturday 22 May:

"Other fires occurred at:

St Leonard's Road, Bromley-by-Bow to premises of Messrs. G. Egner and Sons, butchers".

Similar entry appears in Eastern Post - Saturday 15 May.

East End News - Tuesday 11 May - reported sinking of Lusitania

East End News - Friday 14 May:

"The firm of C Egner and Son, pork and beef butchers, St Leonard's-road, suffered as badly as any place along the road. The place was set on fire, though fortunately not too severely for the fireman's efforts, and every window in the shop and bakehouse was broken and the frames taken out."

There were accounts of half a dozen Germans going to Smithfields to buy meat for their shops. When the porters realised they were Germans they chased them along the road to Aldgate.

East London Observer - Saturday 22 May:

"... no fewer than 80 charges arising out of the attacks on German shops in the East End."

"...there were a number of German and Austrian shops in Cable Street."

In the House of Commons on Monday 17 May, Mr King asked a question of the Home Secretary concerning the anti-German riots. Mr McKenna responded that 257 people had been injured including 107 police and special constables. 866 people had been arrested.

Letters appeared in the papers which acknowledged the provocation leading to these attacks, but deplored them for making innocent people the target of such behaviour.

I am a ggg-gs of GEORGE BINER and SARAH BUDGEN. Their eldest daughter, Sarah Ann, married Christian Warncken in Bethnal Green in 1844. According to my quick calculations this makes us 4th cousins.

Like your Georg Heinrich Egner, my Christian was born in Germany. Unfortunately I have not as yet been able to ascertain where. My immediate folk lived in London's eastern regions (St Geo East through to West Ham and back again) for much of the next century. The families of two of Christian and Sarah's sons moved to the Tottenham area in the 1880s.

I mentioned Bryam Mawer's website in my previous email. Bryan Mawer and I swapped several emails a couple of years ago. They originally stemmed from his interest in workers in sugar refineries and as you are probably aware there were many of these London's East End in the 19th century. It turns out that my Christian Warncken was a "carpenter in a sugar refinery" which definitely interested Bryan. His knowledge of the St Geo East is amazing. Along the way, Bryan provided a lot of other miscellaneous information from his records including the following.

* The regs of St Geo confirm that the entry for Johann H Welbrock was the baptism of his daughter Hannah Sophia, b. 1 Oct 1849, bpt 4 Nov 1849, mother Harriet Sofia Binat of London. No further references to Binat/Biner in those regs or those of St Pauls. There are a number of other Welbrock entries if you decide to investigate further ... including JHW's daughter Catharine Adelaine W, 20, who married JJH Bettjeman, 1877. JHW shown as labourer. Biner is not a surname I'm familiar with in either English or German, but she was "of London."

Just checked the birth registers of the parish of Scharmbeck. I found:

- (1) Hermann Wellbrock, bap. 31 May 1799, Heudamm, son of Harm and Anna nee Wendelken
- (2) Johann Conrad Wellbrock, b. 22 October 1812, Heudamm, son of Harm and Trina nee Bucks
- (3) Johann Hinrich Welbrok, b. 22 January 1820, Heudamm, son of Harm and Margrete nee Garbade

All three were reported to have gone to England, all were born in the same tiny village (Heudamm) in the parish of Scharmbeck, bailiwick / district of Osterholz, they all had a father named Harm. So it seems very likely that they were brothers. Unfortunately, no occupation of the father is given and, most irritating, each of the three seem to have had another mother. So what I will have to do next is check the marriage and deaths registers as well to see if old Harm was married three times! However, this will take me some time.

No. 1 seems to be the one who ran the Black Horse Tavern, no. 3 is definitely the one listed in the 1871 census!

> Gesche Wellbrock was baptised on 5 August 1810. Her parents were school teacher Harm Wellbrock (of Heudamm) and Anna nee Wendelken (baptism register).

Johann Conrad Wellbrock was born in 1812. His parents were Harm Wellbrock and Catharina (Trina) Bucks (baptism register). Harm and Catharina got married on 8 March 1810. The entry in the marriage register shows that Harm Wellbrock was the son of Johann Wellbrock (of Heudamm) while Catharina was a widow and daughter of Hinrich Stelljes

(of Heudamm).

Johann Hinrich Wellbrock was born in 1820. His parents were Harm Wellbrock and Anna Margrete nee Garbade (baptism register). Harm and Anna Margrete got married in 1814. The entry in the marriage register shows that Harm Wellbrock (of Heudamm) was school teacher and widower while Anna Margrete was the daughter of Berend Garbade (of Torfmoor).

Thus Johann Hinrich was a half-brother (not a step brother) of Hermann Wellbrock, David is absolutely correct!! He was also a half-brother of Gesche. Please, note, for lack of time I did not check the complete registers, there may have been more issues to Harm Wellbrock and Anna or second wife Catharina (Trina).

Johann Conrad was no brother of Hermann or Johann Hinrich Wellbrock though they were very probably related to some degree (but I did not find out). I was only interested to find out about the three Wellbrocks who to my knowledge migrated to England / London and especially about JHW, the sugarbaker, the one both of you are also particularly interested in.

Herman Wellbrock died in 1851. You can order his last will from The National Archives (TNA), London. I have not the slightest idea whatever happened to Johann Conrad. Thanks to David we know what JHW was doing in 1871 when the Census was taken. Surprisingly I cannot find JHW in the 1881 Census (which I have on CD Rom)! However, as I already told you, according to FreeBMD he died in 1889 in Greenwich. As far as I know death certificates can be ordered from the GRO. This would show what he was doing in his late years, something I'd be interested in to know.

My research on the migration of Hanoverians into the British sugar industry is going on. Should I come across JHW again, I would, of course, let you know. The same with Christian Warncken!!

Should you ever stumble across Hanoverian / German sugar bakers in England or Australia (there must have been those who worked in the British sugar industry for a while and then emigrated to Australia where they turned farmers!), please, let me know!
